At the end of this seminar, each participant will be able to:

- 1. Improve capacities discriminating the target signal of speech with any background noise
- 2. Describe speech sounds and be aware of differing characteristics
- 3. Improve discrimination of target speech sounds given verbally presented information
- 4. Understand the basic concepts of speech reading and how to employ it in general conversation
- 5. Engage in exercises that address specific speech sounds and sentences in the presence of competing background noise
- 6. Improve general speech understanding by combining visual and auditory management, perception, speech reading and cognitive focus
- 7. Develop a treatment plan for further aural rehabilitation tasks

This is a fun and supportive means to improve overall comprehension skills. It is a 4-week, one (1) hour class composed of lecture, participant interaction and practice sessions. Course is restricted to address specific needs of the company being educated. The number of participants is limited to maximize participating benefit.
